

GOVERNMENT SUBCONTRACT RIDER (REV. G, June 2026)

FAR / DFARS FLOWDOWN CLAUSES

I. Scope

These FAR and DFARS clauses apply to all Purchase Orders (“Orders”) issued by a TE Entity in support of a U.S. Government prime contract or higher-tier subcontract, as required by regulation, the prime contract, or by operation of law.

II. Threshold Interpretation

All references to dollar thresholds shall be interpreted in accordance with:

- **FAR 1.109 (Statutory Acquisition-Related Thresholds)**
- **FAR Case 2024-001 (FAC 2025-06, effective October 1, 2025)**

Current Key Thresholds (effective October 1, 2025)

- Micro-Purchase Threshold (MPT): **\$15,000**
- Simplified Acquisition Threshold (SAT): **\$350,000**
- Anti-Kickback / Lobbying (FAR 3.8): **\$200,000**
- Subcontract Reporting (FAR 52.204-10): **\$40,000**
- Subcontracting Plan Threshold: **\$900,000 (\$2M construction)**
- Truthful Cost or Pricing Data: **\$2,500,000**
- Ethics Program (FAR 52.203-13): **\$7,500,000**

Interpretation Rule:

If a clause in this rider references an outdated dollar threshold, the **current FAR-adjusted threshold shall control**.
