Dear Valued Supplier Partner,

TE Connectivity is writing to inform you that we are transitioning away from **Assent**, our current regulatory compliance partner.

TE has selected **Source Intelligence (SI)** and its **Compliance Map (CMAP)** platform as our new solution for supplier data collection and regulatory compliance management. CMAP will be used to collect and manage supplier declarations for the following requirements:

- EU RoHS
- EU REACH (EU REACH SVHCs, Annexes XIV and XVII)
- TE Banned & Targeted Substances
- PFAS Identification
- TE Low Halogen
- California Proposition 65
- Mined Minerals reporting (including **CMRT**, **EMRT**, and **AMRT**)

Action Required

After logging into CMAP, confirm your primary and backup compliance email contacts who will receive communications and coordinate responses within your organization.

Detailed step-by-step instructions for completing specific surveys and uploads will be provided separately through CMAP training materials and supplier guidance.

Supplier Declaration and Document Submission Process

When responding to TE's Product Environmental Compliance (PEC) and Responsible Sourcing data requests for the parts supplied to TE, TE's preferred approach is for you to provide a **Full Material Declaration (FMD)**. This helps streamline your responses by enabling the same declaration data to be leveraged across multiple regulatory requirements, reducing the need for you to complete separate, regulation-specific surveys.

If you choose not to provide a Full Material Declaration, you will instead be asked to complete regulation-specific survey questions for each applicable requirement. Supporting documentation may be required to substantiate your declaration.

Submitting Declarations Through CMAP

When submitting a **Supplier Response (SR)**, select **Class C – Material Summary**.

When submitting a **Full Material Declaration (FMD)**, select **Class D – Full Material Disclosure**.

- You will manually enter the required data into the portal.
- The system will automatically generate a PDF based on your entries.
- This PDF is stored with the CMAP application.

Submitting Existing Documentation

If you prefer to submit **existing** IPC-1752A XML files, you may do so by:

- Replying to the **system-generated email** and attaching the IPC-1752A XML.
- The CMAP system will automatically process the IPC-1752A XML received via email.

CMAP Training Options

Each supplier required to submit compliance declarations to TE will receive a separate email with instructions on how to access CMAP training materials.

Training includes:

- Self-paced, online modules covering each regulation or survey.
- A dedicated module explaining how to properly complete declarations within CMAP.

Implementation Timeline

- **Supplier Notification:** Week of June 8, 2026
- **TE-Hosted CMAP Training:** Weeks of July 13 and July 20, 2026
- **CMAP Go-Live:** June 16, 2026

Important

The **Assent Compliance Tool** will no longer be available as of **Sunday, June 14, 2026 at 00:00 Eastern Time (UTC-4)**, as TE transitions fully to CMAP.

Go-Live and Ongoing Requests

TE plans to **go live with CMAP on June 16, 2026**.

- **Notifications from CMAP** will be sent via email to your designated compliance contact, requesting updates for parts supplied to TE **beginning June 23, 2026**.
 - Reminder emails will be sent until the requested data has been submitted.
 - Notify TE of any changes to a part's compliance status by emailing: suppliercompliancesupport@te.com
