

Dear Supplier,

The New TYCO ELECTRONICS SUPPLIER SURVEY FOR COMPLIANCE

Please bring this to the immediate attention of your Product Compliance Manager or CEO.

You are already familiar with the constantly evolving global legislation and environmental requirements for Product Compliance. This legislation includes RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances, Directive 2002/95/EC, which restricts certain hazardous substances in products that will be sold into Europe and which became effective July 2006), as well as REACH, (the European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use, EC 1907/2006, for Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances, which went into effect June 2007). To successfully market products globally and grow our business (and our Suppliers' business), we must all satisfy these and other global compliance regulations. In addition, Tyco Electronics (TE) is actively supporting industry initiatives such as Low Halogen which go beyond current legislation in our ongoing efforts to reduce impact of electronic products/materials on the environment. To meet these requirements, companies in the supply chain have no choice but to cooperate, which means that each of us must report our products' compliance and/or use of certain substances to our Customers. Global Customers absolutely demand it.

In mid-December 2009, Tyco Electronics implemented a new online application, the TE Supplier Survey for Compliance, or "SSC". The purpose of SSC is to provide a single point for Supplier reporting for all of the existing and evolving compliance legislation for parts/ products/ materials that Tyco Electronics purchases. Your reporting will allow TE to report the compliance of our finished products to our Customers. It also will allow us to subsequently work with you to address any product compliance issues wherever necessary.

We have attempted to make product compliance reporting as easy as possible for our Suppliers. We need your responses to the SSC on an on-going basis. Your prompt completion of this critical reporting and ongoing updates as necessary are required for your company to secure future business with Tyco Electronics.

As soon as you receive this Letter, please stop reporting your product compliance data via the old TE RoHS Survey, and instead use the following steps to respond via the new TE Supplier Survey for Compliance:

1. Go to the Tyco Electronics Supplier Web Portal located here: <https://supplierportal.tycoelectronics.com>
2. Log onto the TE Supplier Portal (if you are not yet registered, use this **PDF** to do so <http://www.tycoelectronics.com/supplier/reg.pdf>). Also use the registration process to request access to the Supplier Survey for Compliance,
3. Once logged on, select "BUSINESS APPLICATIONS" from the Top Menu, and from that pulldown select "QUALITY AND COMPLIANCE". Then, under "QUALITY AND COMPLIANCE", click on the **SUPPLIER SURVEY FOR COMPLIANCE**. When the SSC starts, please follow the instructions within the Application.
4. Be sure to complete each of the steps for each Survey, starting with the General Survey, and then answering the compliance questions by part as they flow to the various compliance Surveys (RoHS, REACH, Low Halogen, Banned/ Restricted Substances). As you complete responses, be sure to sign and submit them.
5. Check the SSC frequently and provide your responses to any newly-requested parts, or parts that have changed compliance status. We will also send you email reminders of unanswered parts.
