As part of TE Connectivity's (TE) commitment to sustainability and carbon emission reductions, we are expanding our efforts to address Scope 3 emissions across our value chain. Your partnership is essential in helping us meet our corporate climate goals and respond to increasing customer and regulatory expectations for transparency and environmental responsibility.

Earlier this year, we introduced the [TE Supplier Code of Conduct](#) campaign. In alignment with the responsibilities outlined in Chapter V of the Code, we will be collecting key sustainability data starting in **December 2025**. This data will help establish baselines, monitor progress in reducing emissions from purchased goods and services, ensure regulatory compliance and support required reporting.

To streamline this process, we will use **Regrello**, a secure workflow tool, to request and manage sustainability-related data. These requests may include:

- Product Carbon Footprints (PCFs)
- Product Net Weights
- Renewable Energy Usage
- Recycled Content Information
- Other regulatory required environmental sustainability data

Please note: No onboarding or registration is required. Regrello is invite-only, and you will receive direct access without creating an account or entering login credentials. Please treat communications from Regrello as legitimate and safe. It is important that your teams respond to requests promptly and accurately, as this data is critical to our sustainability reporting and customer commitments.
