RE: Additional Communication on TE Connectivity's Support to Critical Sectors

Dear Valued TE Connectivity Suppliers,

Further to our prior Covid-19 related communications, TE Connectivity and its affiliated companies (TE) are aware of the recent and ongoing governmental declarations restricting movement and business operations to help fight the Covid-19 pandemic. Because TE manufactures and contributes products to essential and/or life-saving businesses, it is TE's intention and obligation to continue to operate during this event to the extent we are able within legal limits. We want to provide context around this decision to assist our supply chain partners in deciding how to respond to the various governmental directives and restrictions.

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) executes the Secretary of Homeland Security's responsibilities as assigned under the Homeland Security Act of 2002, and TE serves as a [member](https://www.cisa.gov/critical-infrastructure-sectors) of CISA's Critical Manufacturing Sector Council. CISA has identified a range of operations and services that are essential to continued critical infrastructure viability as outlined in <https://www.cisa.gov/critical-infrastructure-sectors>.

TE Connectivity's products and related operations fall within these identified critical infrastructure sectors, including but not limited to medical, defense, energy, transportation and critical manufacturing sectors. Accordingly, it is TE Connectivity's special responsibility to remain operational during this unprecedented event.

As an essential supplier to TE Connectivity in support of the above referenced essential critical infrastructure sectors, we ask that you take this into consideration as you evaluate your on-going operations. To the extent that you anticipate any impact to your ability to support TE Connectivity, we would like to understand what steps your business may be taking to mitigate any risks to TE in continuing such supply to TE Connectivity globally.

As always, the health and safety of your employees and the public is paramount, so we ask that you also follow the CDC preventative and mitigating guidelines to protect your employee population. As previously communicated, TE Connectivity is continuing to follow the social distancing practices and mitigating measures defined by the CDC to protect the health and safety of our workforce.
